The Western edges of the Okavango Delta are some of the wettest and most permanent parts that exist. These permanent swamps with their thick papyrus and reed beds, through which the deep channels flow, are a marvel to behold. These areas are the life blood to the rest of the delta and provide a home for a host of species. Hippos and crocodiles rule the waterways, as elephants crisscross the marshes between the islands in search of food. Red Lechwe also inhabits the islands of dry amongst the surrounding wetlands.

A helicopter scenic allows you to get the bigger picture and see this incredible ecosystem branch out to create the Okavango Delta panhandle. All guests will be able to explore with a doors off window seat guaranteed for unrestricted photo and video opportunities over some of the most pristine and unreachable areas, as well as being provided with headsets for a truly guided experience.

TSODILO HILLS EXPERIENCE

Return Doors-On Helicopter Transfers & Tsodilo Hills Experience

3-Hour experience to Tsodilo Hills; guided by a local rock art expert; entrance fees & picnic lunch.

Explore this UNESCO World Heritage Site, firstly from the air and then by foot. This half-day trip includes a flight to Tsodilo Hills, which encompasses the entirety of the awe-inspiring Okavango Delta. From seasonal floodplains, over permanent lagoons of the panhandle, right to the snaking meandering river, you get to witness untamed beauty from up in the air. Once you have reached your destination, you will be greeted by a local rock art expert who will explain some of the 4500 rock paintings that adorn the quartzite rocks. You will learn about the history of the human settlement of this site, which dates back around 100,000 years. Tsodilo Hills presents a side of Botswana that few travellers get to experience. The hills have an air and allure that is difficult to describe; perhaps they possess a draw that appeals to something within us all.

Return Doors-On Helicopter Transfers & CLAWS and Life With Elephants

1-Hour experience at CLAWS; 2-Hour experience at Eretsha Village; guided tour.

The experience combines a visit to two community coexistence projects located in a remote part of the Okavango Delta. Human & Wildlife conflict is a daily concern for many people living remotely in Botswana. The CLAWS project is run by the community to reduce carnivore conflict and benefit livestock owners with veterinary assistance and improved rangelands. The experience includes a talk with the head herdsman and a guided tour of the bomas. The Life With Elephants project, located in the traditional Hambukushu village of Eretsha, was created by the conservation NGO, Ecoexist, in an effort to increase benefits coming back to communities that coexist with elephants. Experience the Okavango Delta and the diverse landscape from above on your return flight. By booking this experience you offer support to both projects.

This experience includes return helicopter transfers, learning the stories of each orphaned elephant, guided by informed and knowledgeable handlers, and a donation towards the organisation.
